Discovers Windover Farms

During the hot, humid summer a film crew from England weathered the Florida climate, much as the ancient people they were documenting did. Mosquitos, bugs and Sand Hill Cranes are some of the things the world will see when the Learning Channel airs their documentary of the ancient burial grounds located in Windover Farms.

Johanna Gibbon, Director/Producer and her film crew, Electric Sky Company, spent three days filming in Windover farms. Electric Sky is the company that filmed the documentary "Raising the Mammoth". Funding for this documentary was provided through the Discovery Channel.

The burial ground is unique in many ways. Ninety-one of the burials were recovered with their brains intact. Thirty-five were recovered with fabric materials.

The Learning Channel will air the program sometime in November. Time and date of the Documentary will be on the website as soon as it is available.
